

Rules for AEA-Retired Holiday Gift Exchange

1. Final interpretation of **all** rules will be determined by the judge, me.
2. Bring a wrapped gift to the December 13, 2016 meeting.
3. Trade your gift for a number and place your gift exchange item in the designated place.
4. President Julie will go first and last. (No Whining-she's the Pres.)
5. When your number is called you are to select any unopened gift or steal an already opened gift.
6. If you choose to "steal," you select from those who have come before you. Then the person from whom you have stolen selects an unopened gift.
7. The next number is called. The game continues until the last number is called. After all selections have been made, then President Julie may choose to trade her original selection for any gift. (There has got to be a benefit to being President.)

NOTES: You may not hide a gift because you like it and don't want it stolen.

Do not tell others what you have brought as information is powerful.

Working in teams is forbidden.
